Exceptional 3 on 3 “Bubble Kid” Hockey Leagues Since 2004

*** It's ESP's “Combined Spring / Fall” Mite Bubble Level 4 League**

Who: More than a decade ago, ESP Hockey became the true champions of fringe players. Our 2017 3 on 3 “Bubble Kid Hockey Leagues” will feature for the second year, a level for athletes who last winter were primarily **strong final year Level #3 Mites & Level #4 mites that were role players on their mite winter club teams, who are looking leap ahead skill wise prior to next year's squirt tryouts.** However, players of similar skill who will remain mites next fall can also play in order to fill teams, and have friends play together...

Where: The Cottage Grove Ice Arena – Studio Rink... This is not some inferior split ice 3 on 3 “touch up deal”. The unique 130' x 65' fully enclosed ice sheet shown below is the real thing. It's the centerpiece of the developmentally superior venue that we've perfected over the past several years.



When: The league is split into **two seasons**. It's **six 1 hour games** in the spring commencing week 3 in April & ending week 3 in May. **The final six 1 hour games** for fall will begin week 3 in July & will end week 3 in September. Each team should expect 3 to 5 games starting at 5PM on varying weeknights & 7 to 9 games on weekend mornings or early afternoons as a typical game day mix. League approved player substitutions are allowed with signed waivers.

Why: 3 on 3 hockey creates quick hands, quick feet, and quick thinking. It also builds a more creative player & enhances ice vision & instincts. These are true separators between similarly skilled athletes. This is your player's chance to have their “Ah Ha” moment... Big ice 5 on 5, or even full size sheet 4 on 4 can't offer that?

What: We will look to field 4 or 5 teams per level from all parts of the metro. A few from out-state are likely as well. The teams will generally play each other two to four times over the entire year. We understand how to create team & player skill parody & are quite fanatical about it. Competitive games create additional developmental value. A tight range of player ability team by team creates numerous individual battles that either player can win. This creates **Elevated Skill Progression**. Our **Leapfrog Effect** is unmatched.

Cost: The team fee is **\$1590** (Less than \$14 per hour per player) based on the bare minimum 9 skaters & 1 goalie we'll allow. But we **strongly recommend 11 skaters and 1 goalie** so in season sports, and or summer vacation conflicts are covered with enough remaining players for at least 2 lines each game. The fee is just \$133 per player with 12 per team. The fee includes jerseys for all rostered players. **Either way, 3 on 3 games provide over 40% more player puck time than 5 on 5.** If you have a few players but can't field a full team, we'll work to place them on a team in need of players so they won't miss out on a unique hockey opportunity!!

Format: “Full” 1 hour games. 2 minute timed shifts. USA Hockey referees. Penalty shots for rules violations.

Stature: The ESP Hockey “Bubble Kid” 3 on 3 leagues, 3 on 3 tournaments, & round robin events have hosted over 450 teams & over 4500 players since 2004. The NHL has certainly concluded 3 on 3 is a great game with the All-Star 3 on 3 Challenge and its new overtime format adopted during the 2015-16 season. If you believe your athlete can benefit from authentic 3 on 3 let your coach know right away as teams will fill up quickly!
